

Each age group will have a male and female category



Event Format

SCSA Lead Titles will conform to SCA Lead Competition format, scoring and rules outlined <u>here</u>.

Youth C and D will compete on Top Rope. They will compete in the 4 climbs format.

Open A, Open B, Masters, Juniors, Youth A and Youth B will compete on lead in the qualifier + Final format.

These Categories will have 2 predetermined qualifying routes and 1 finals route. Qualifier 1 and Qualifier 2 will be climbed in parallel. The qualifying running orders will be posted online May 13th 5pm. The top 8 climbers after Qualifiers will compete in Finals.

All categories will be scored using IFSC scoring - points per hold with a plus (+) awarded for positive movement towards the next hold.

Participants will be provided a full technical briefing before their session commences where any questions will be answered.

Youth and Junior Competitors in Open A

Youth and Junior competitors who wish to compete in Open A as well as their age category will need to register and pay for both categories.

Interstate Competitors

Interstate competitors may compete but are not eligible for the South Australian Title. Interstate competitors are eligible for national level ranking if they are current SCA national level members.

International Competitors

International competitors may compete but are not eligible for the South Australian Title. International competitors must be members of SCSA.

Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority

As an Olympic Sport, Sport Climbing is now subject to anti-doping controls, managed by Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) in Australia. Anti-doping plays an important part in keeping competitors safe and competitions fair. Sports Climbing Australia is working with the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency (ASADA) to keep the sport clean. Drug testing may take place at any national competition and members of the Australian Team are also subject to random testing in and out of the competition season.
