- There will also be \$5 spectator fee collected for each day

c. Event Format

Event format will be held in accordance with the Sport Climbing Australia Competition Policy for Lead State Titles with the following for:

Open A & B, Inclusive, Masters, Para and Youth A, B:

- 2 qualifying routes to be climbed 'flash' format with forerunning on video or forerunning before the round starts
- 1 final route to be climbed in an 'onsight' format where competitors will be given a viewing period and then will be held in isolation before their attempt begins.

YD & YC format

• A single round of four (4) non-identical routes for each. These routes will be of 'flash' format on Top Rope. There will be no isolation time for YD & YC competitors.

3. Categories

Competitors competing in youth categories are categorised by male and female gender unless a competitive chooses to sign up in the youth inclusive category. **

Youth D - born 2009 or after
Youth C - born 2007/2008
Youth B - born 2005/2006
Youth A - born 2003/2004
Junior - born 2001/2002

Youth Inclusive - no gender identifiers (under 16/born before 2003) *see note below

Adult Categories

Competitors competing in open categories are categorised by male and female gender unless a competitive chooses to sign up in the open inclusive category.**

Open A – born 2003 or earlier (grade 23+)

Open B – born 2003 or earlier (up to grade 23 for Male and 21 for Female) 15 yrs

The purpose of Open B is to introduce climbers to competitions. If a competitor has podiumed in Open B in the past 2 years, the SCV reserves the right to move

your registration category to Open A.

Open Inclusive - no gender identifiers (16+/born 2003 or earlier) *see note below

Masters – born 1980 or earlier

- competitor with disability

- * Youth Inclusive Category/Open Inclusive Category These categories are for competitive climbers who are not interested in a gender identifier in SCV competition. Climbers in our inclusive category are not identified by male/female language, and we support any competitive climbers to climb in this category. When announcing this category, we will use a climber's name and non-gendered pronouns. If a competitive climber (in any category) has a preferred pronoun, please let us know. While we will have state podiums for our inclusive competitive climbers, please know that this is not yet a recognised category for qualifying for national competition. This is the first time for this category, so we welcome feedback and questions.
- ** Male category includes any competitive climber who self-identifies as male
- ** Female category includes any competitive climber who self-identifies as female

The general toilets in the facility are labeled male and female. There is a single stall toilet behind the indoor soccer facility, two at the Coles across the parking lot, and a portable accessible toilet located outside the gym near the registration area.

General:

Any questions? We've asked for advice and support from the Climbing QT's for the inclusive category. Feel free to ask us or ask them to present a question to us (if you feel uncomfortable asking us directly.)







For our para athletes, we get advice and support from our Adaptive Climbing Committee. Feel free to ask us questions directly or contact them at adaptive@sportclimbingvictoria.com.au.

If any climber requires reduced auditory stimulation / relative quiet for the duration of their climb, please identify this with the judge at the start of your climb.

There are three designated accessible car parks at the main entrance to the sports centre. There will be a portable accessible toilet located outside the gym near the registration area.

All climbers are welcome to have a support person accompany them to the wall at which point officials will guide the support person with regards to safe places to stand.

a. Youth Competitors in Open A

Youth A and Junior

Youth A and Junior competitors who wish to compete in Open A as well as their age category will need to register and pay for both categories.

Youth B

Youth B competitors who are on the Australian team will be allowed to climb the Open A routes in the same competition format as Open A at a time suitable to the organisers. They will not receive a score or a ranking.

b. Interstate competitors

Interstate competitors are allowed to compete but are not eligible for titles. They are eligible for ranking and prizes.

c. Foreign Competitors

Foreign competitors are welcome to compete. Foreign competitors will be eligible for prizes but not for an Australian ranking. Foreign climbers must also be members of Sport Climbing Australia.







4. Volunteers

Don't want to compete? Well, by becoming a judge, competition belayer or other official, you will better understand how competitions work and enjoy a sense of fulfillment in being an integral part of making it happen. In saying that, being a volunteer at a climbing event requires patience, motivation, commitment, punctuality, stamina, calmness and being a team player. If you feel you have these qualities then we look forward to you being part of the volunteer family.

5. Support in Isolation

For categories with finals any competitor can nominate a support person to enter the Isolation Zone with them if that competitor qualifies for finals. This person must comply with the rules applying to Team Officials and all others in the Isolation Zone. This includes:

- that they must enter the zone prior to the zone closing time
- that they must register with the Isolation Official on entering
- once having entered, they cannot communicate with any other person outside the zone and must leave all communication devices with the Isolation Zone official
- Should this person wish to leave the Isolation Zone, they are permitted and able to do so by communicating with the Isolation Zone official
- once they have left the zone, they cannot re-enter (except for supervised toilet visits, in the same manner as athletes.)

6. Spectators

Please be advised that Cliffhanger gym is busy and noisy during the competition. We endeavour to make it possible for spectators to see all of the climbers, but please note there is no specified seating areas for spectators. Information on disabled parking and unisex toilets is listed above (following competition categories.)
