Registration

All competitors must be current State or National members of Sport Climbing Australia.

State level membership is \$20

Any competitor who participated in the 2020 Lead state Titles or 2020 Boulder state titles are already members and would only need to register and pay for Skyfall. Climbers are required to preregister for the competition.

Entry fee

Early Bird \$45 (until 30th October)

Early Bird/ Skyfall comp Tee \$65 (until 30th October)

Standard Entry \$60 (closes midnight 10th November)

Registrations will not be accepted after midnight 10th of November

Competition format

Youth D	Top Rope
Youth C	Lead qualifiers and finals.
Youth B	Lead qualifiers and finals.
Youth A	Lead qualifiers and finals.
Juniors	Lead qualifiers and finals.

Youth D will have 4 non identical climbs in a single round without a final.

All other Youth categories will consist of 2 non-identical routes in a flash format. Finals will be in on-sight format for the top 8 from each category.

Youth D	Born 2010 /2011
Youth C	Born 2009/2008
Youth B	Born 2007/2006
Youth A	Born 2005/2004
Juniors	Born 2003/2002

Rules and Regulations

- a) An attempt shall be deemed to have started, and measurement of the climbing time shall start, when every part of the competitor's body has left the ground
- b) Competitors will receive 1 attempt per climb only in all rounds
- c) Scoring in Qualifications will be done in accordance to the hold number a climber reaches and/or controls, a "+" being recorded where a hold is reached but not controlled
- d) Scoring for Semi-Final and Final rounds will include the time taken for a competitor to complete their climb. In case of tied points time will be used to separate competitors
- e) An attempt on a route shall be considered successful if the route has been climbed in accordance with the rules and if the rope has been clipped into the karabiner on the final quickdraw of the route (or two hands are placed on the final hold of a top rope climb for 3 seconds) within the fixed time period for attempts.
- f) The attempt of a competitor on a route shall be considered unsuccessful if the competitor:
 - i) Falls.
 - ii) Exceeds the fixed climbing time for the route.
 - iii) Returns to the ground with any part of the body after having started their attempt.
 - iv) Uses any part of the wall, holds or features that are deemed out of bounds or not allowable.
- g) The fixed length of the climbing period in the Qualification round shall be six (6) minutes for each route.
- h) The fixed length of the climbing period in the Finals rounds shall be eight (8) minutes for each route

Finals Procedure

- a) The top 8 climbers from the combined score of the qualifier rounds compete in an on-sight final.
- b) During the final, competitors must remain within a designated Isolation Zone until their turn to climb. Unauthorized personnel are not permitted to enter the Isolation Zone.
- c) A collective observation period for all finalists shall be held immediately prior to the commencement of the finals round.

d) Climbers are escorted by an official to the Competition Area. Whilst in the

Competition Area, competitors are not permitted to seek any information from persons outside the Competition Area (e.g. members of the public, coaches etc.).
