### Format and Rules

#### Qualification Selection Process

It is a requirement for all Open A participants to have been qualified to participate in the event. See SCA selection policy for National for details. Open B and Master participants will be offered a place in order of registration until the maximum number of participants is reached.

#### 1. OPEN B and MASTER Categories

1.1 All categories will participate in a 5 problem qualification round on Saturday the 18th of November.

1.2 Each round of qualifications will run for 2 hours.

1.3 During the qualification, each group will have 5 problems to attempt in the allocated time.

1.4 Top 6 competitors will proceed to finals where they will attempt 4 problems within a 5 on 5 format.

1.5 Each problem will be scored with bonuses and tops as per IFSC standards. Placings will be awarded according to the number of problems the climbers complete. Climbers who complete the same number of problems will be separated according to how many attempts they took to complete the problems. If this still results in a tie, the number of bonus holds achieved by the climbers and the number of attempts taken to achieve them will be taken into consideration. In the event of a tie, after counting attempts and bonuses, there will be a count back to previous rounds results. In the event there is still a tie for a top 3 position a Tie Break Boulder will be held.

1.6 Climbers must start each attempt from the marked starting hand and foot holds. Touching, with hands or feet, holds other than the marked starting holds from the ground is not permitted.

1.7 Competitors may brush the holds from the ground using the brushes provided.

1.8 When wishing to attempt a problem, the climber must hand their score sheet to the wall judge. The wall judge will call the climbers in the order he/she received the score sheets and record the climber's attempt.

1.9 If the climber uses an illegal hold, touches the mat in any way, or otherwise negates their attempt the judge will ask them to stop.

1.10 The judge's decision is final as there is no opportunity for appeal in this format.

1.11 Climbers are expected to be familiar with the SCA Boulder regulations relating to starting, finishing and achieving bonus holds.

1.12 All competitors must be current National members of Sport Climbing Australia. \$59 for nationals for the calendar year. Join at the SCA website.

1.13 Climbers who are colour-blind need to notify the route setters at [hello@nomadbouldering.com](mailto:hello@nomadbouldering.com) at least one week prior to the event.
