Competitor Categories

- Open A Born 2001 or before (Advanced)
- Open B Born 2001 or before (Intermediate)
- Masters Born 1977 or before
- Junior Born 1998/1999
- Youth A Born 2000/2001
- Youth B Born 2002/2003
- Youth C Born 2004/2005
- Youth D Born 2006 and after

Youth A and Junior competitors who wish to compete in Open A as well as their age category will need to register and pay for both categories. Youth B competitors who are on the Australian team will be allowed to participate in the Open A category but are not eligible for Titles or ranking.

Interstate Competitors

Interstate competitors are allowed to compete but are not eligible for Titles. They are eligible for ranking and prizes.

Non Citizens Residing in Australia

Competitors with a SA registered address with SCA can compete and are entitled to Titles, ranking and prizes.

International Guest Competitors

International competitors are allowed to compete but are not eligible for Titles. They are eligible for ranking and prizes.

Rules

To compete in this competition the climber agrees to follow all rules and regulations outlined in this information pack and follow the rules and procedures of the hosting gym.

Rules for the event will be detailed in the briefing period before the commencement of each round of competition. Any questions or clarification regarding the rules must be asked during this time.

Format

Youth C, Youth D, Open B & Masters – Pumpfest

These categories will compete in a 'pumpfest', where climbers will receive 2 hours to complete as many problems as they wish. The competitors highest scoring 8 problems will determine their score and ranking.

Youth A, Youth B & Juniors - Boulderjam

These categories will compete in a 'boulderjam', where climbers will receive 2 hours to complete 7 specific problems, marked with tops and bonuses. The competitors with the most number of tops (and bonuses) in the least number of attempts are ranked higher. There will be no finals event for these categories.

Open A – Boulderjam Qualifier then 5on/50off Final

These categories will have a qualifier round and then a final round. The qualifier will be in a 'boulderjam' format where climbers will receive 2 hours to complete 5 specific problems, marked with tops and bonuses. The final event will be in 5on/5off format on 4 problems (top 6 of each category).
