

The Event

Introduction

This year the Arc'teryx Open Lead and Boulder Championships will be held in St Peters and Villawood NSW.

The Open Lead and Boulder Championships will decide the Australian Champion in Lead and Boulder. It is also the selection event for the Australian Team.

Dates

The event will be held from Thursday 17 November until Sunday 20 November 2022.

The Boulder competition will run on Thursday and Friday. The Lead competition will be on Saturday and Sunday. Please refer to the event timetable in this handbook for more details.

Open B Category

Open B category is a friendly and social category. It is recommended for participants who have not qualified for Open A and wish to be part of a social event on **national competition** quality routes.

Non-citizens Residing in Australia

Foreign citizens who are currently residing in Australia are eligible for an Australian ranking and prizes but not for Australian Titles. Only Australian citizens can receive an official placing at the championship. Non-citizens residing in Australia must have a current valid Sport Climbing Australia national membership.

International Guest Competitors

Places and medals can only be awarded to Australian residents. Overseas guest competitors must be a current national member of Sport Climbing Australia. Overseas guest competitors who make it to a final or semi-final do so as part of the final or semi-final quota, with no extra places made for resident climbers.

Youth Competitors in Open

Youth A and Junior wishing to compete in Open A (Selection via state association)

Youth A and juniors competing in Open A are eligible for title, ranking and prizes as any Open A competitor.





Selection Process

Open A

This category is subject to a strict selection process accessible via states selection

The state boards are responsible for selecting their state teams. Competitors not automatically selected via their state titles should contact their respective state board.

Anti-doping

All Sport Climbing Australia National Level events are subject to ASADA anti-doping testing.

Education

It is recommended you complete anti-doping education through ASADA eLearning prior to attending this event. ASADA eLearning is a free and easy to use online education tool developed by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA).

Queries regarding routes and technicalities can be directed to the head route setter. Questions regarding format, registration and any other queries can be directed to the event organiser.

Rules

To compete in this competition the climber agrees to follow all rules and regulations outlined in this information pack and follow the rules and procedures of the hosting gym.

This competition will run in conjunction with the Sport Climbing Australia rules. Please find the full rules and regulations at the SCA website:

Rules for the event will be detailed in the briefing period before the commencement of each round of competition. Any questions or clarification regarding the rules must be asked during this time.

Lead Competition Format

• Open A: Qualifier – Semi Final - Final

The Lead event will include 2 flash qualifier climbs for each category. This will be followed by one onsight semi-final climb for the top 26 climbers in each gender. And a final for the top 8 climbers of each gender



• Paraclimbers : Qualifier - Final

The Lead event will include 2 flash qualifier climbs. This will be followed by one onsight final for the top 8 climbers in each gender and category

Boulder Competition Format

• Open A: Qualifier – Semi Final – Final

Open A competitors will compete in a full World Cup Format including qualifier, semi-final and final.

• Open B and Masters

Open B and Master competitors will compete in a boulderjam qualifier followed by a 5on/5off final format

Overall Ranking

The overall ranking will be determined as per the 2022 Overall ranking policy

The ranking of one individual athlete in each discipline will be taken as the relative ranking amongst the overall participants only (only the competitors participating in the two disciplines). The score for each participant will be the multiplication of the two rankings.

Important Information

- Climbers in Open A, will lead all routes.
- Paraclimbers will tope rope all routes in the lead category
- Climbers who are colour-blind need to notify the route setters via info@sportclimbingaustralia.org.au at least one week prior to the event.
- By registering for this competition, the climber authorises SCA to images/photographs/movies that may be taken at the event. To revoke authorisation of the use of personal photographs taken from the event, the climber must submit in writing no later than the 3rd November 2022
