



# 2.1 Registration and Fee

Registration for the competition will be online only on the Sport Climbing Australia website Please note there will be two different entry costs for the event:

- Normal Price (until midnight 14th March 2018): \$25
- Last Minute (from 15<sup>th</sup> March 2018 until close of the registration on 18<sup>th</sup> March 2018): \$35

#### 2.4 Event Format

Event format will be held following IFSC Speed rules as a guideline.

All speed routes are attempted on standard speed auto-belay.

The time to complete the route determines a competitor's ranking in qualifications followed by a round of 16 elimination.

Open, Masters, Juniors, Youth A and Youth B climbers will climb the standard world cup route.

Youth C, D and Paraclimbing will climb a modified route set specifically for the event

Youth D - born 2007 or after
Youth C - born 2005/2006
Youth B - born 2003/2004
Youth A - born 2001/2002
Junior - born 1999/2000

# **Adult Categories**

Open – born 2002 or before

Masters – born 1978 or before

# 3.1 Youth Competitors in Open A

#### Youth A and Junior

Youth A and Junior competitors who wish to compete in Opens as well as their age category will need to register and pay for both categories.

#### Youth B

Youth B competitors who are on the Australian team will be allowed to climb the Open category but they will not receive a score or a ranking.

#### 3.2 Interstate competitors

Interstate competitors are allowed to compete but are not eligible for titles. They are eligible for ranking.

# 3.3 Foreign Competitors

Foreign competitors are welcome to compete. Foreign competitors can compete but will not be eligible for an Australian ranking. Foreign climbers must also be members of Sport Climbing Australia.
