## Introduction

The 2018 State Boulder Titles will be held at Adrenaline Vault WA.

The format is a Boulder Jam for all Youth and Junior categories. Open B Boulder Jam plus final top 6. Open A Boulder Jam Plus Semi Final top 12 and Final top 6.

This event will decide the West Australian State team for bouldering and qualifies for National ranking points.

The event will be held from Saturday the 21<sup>st</sup> of July to Sunday the 22<sup>nd</sup> of July.  
The Boulder Jams will be held on the Saturday and the Semi/Finals on the Sunday.

## Categories and participant requirements

### Youth Categories

- Youth D – born 2007 or after
- Youth C – born 2005/2006
- Youth B – born 2003/2004
- Youth A – born 2001/2002
- Junior – born 1999/2000

### Adult Categories

- Open C – born 2002 or before (Novice)
- Open B – born 2002 or before (Intermediate)
- Open A - born 2002 or before
- Masters – born 1979 or before

### Youth A and Junior

Youth A and Junior competitors who wish to compete in Open A as well as their age category will need to register and pay for both categories.

Youth B competitors who are on the Australian team will be allowed to climb the Open A routes in the same competition format as Open A. They will not receive a score or a ranking.

## Interstate Competitors

Interstate competitors are allowed to compete but are not eligible for titles. They are eligible for ranking and prizes.

## None Citizens Residing in Australia

Competitors with a WA registered address with SCA can compete and are entitled to Titles, ranking and prizes.

## International Guest Competitors

International competitors are allowed to compete but are not eligible for titles. They are eligible for ranking and prizes.

## Registration and Event Fee

Registration will close on the 18<sup>th</sup> of July NO registration will be accepted after this date.

To compete in State Titles, you must have a valid State membership. The state membership is \$20

The Bouldering event has a registration fee;

Early bird is \$45 entry 9<sup>th</sup> of June to 8th of July.

Late entry \$55 9th of July to the 18<sup>th</sup> of July
