1) Date

4) Categories



There will be Male and Female categories:

Youth Top Rope Born 2007 and after

Youth Lead Born 2007 and after

Open Top Rope Born 2006 and before

Intermediate Lead Born 2006 and before Women's up to Grade 21, Men's up to Grade 23

Open Lead Born 2006 and before

5) Registration

All competitors must be current State or National members of Sport Climbing Australia. State level membership is \$20 and supports the sport you love. Any competitor who participated in the 2019 Lead state Titles or 2019 Boulder state titles are already members and would only need to register and pay for Skyfall. Climbers are required to preregister for the competition, entry fee;

\$45 Before 6th of November

Comp fee and the very awesome Skyfall comp T-shirt combo \$65 closing **6th of November** \$60 late registration

Registrations will not be accepted after the 27th of November.

6) Competition Format

Youth Top Rope and Open Top Rope will Top Rope all routes Youth Lead, Intermediate Lead and Open Lead will lead all routes.

The qualifying round is a Pump-Fest, will consist of up to 8 routes per category in a flash format deciding the top 6 from each category. Competitors will self-score this round however SCWA might have judges assisting on some routes. Competitors will need to provide their own belayer for qualification rounds, this may be another competitor.

Finals will be of an On-sight format for the top 6 for all categories, belayers will be provided for finals.

7) Rules and Regulations



- a) An attempt shall be deemed to have started when every part of the competitor's body has left the ground
- b) Competitors will receive 1 attempt per climb in a flash format.
- Scoring in Qualifications will be done in accordance to the hold number a climber reaches and controls
- d) An attempt on a route shall be considered successful if the route has been climbed in accordance with the rules and if the rope has been clipped into the karabiner on the final quickdraw of the route (or two hands are placed on the final hold of a top rope climb in a controlled manner) within the fixed time period for attempts.
- e) The attempt of a competitor on a route shall be considered unsuccessful if the competitor:
 - i. Falls.
 - ii. Exceeds the fixed climbing time for the route.
 - iii. Returns to the ground with any part of the body after having started their attempt.
 - iv. Uses any part of the wall, holds or features that are deemed out of bounds or not allowable.
- f) The fixed length of the climbing period in the Finals rounds shall be eight (8) minutes for each route



8) Finals Procedure

- a) The top 6 climbers from the combined score of the qualifier rounds from each category have an on-sight final.
- b) During the final competitors must remain within a designated Isolation Zone until their turn to climb. Unauthorized personnel are not permitted to enter the Isolation Zone.
- c) A collective observation period for all finalists shall be held immediately prior to the commencement of the finals round.
- d) Climbers are escorted by an official to the Competition Area. Whilst in the Competition Area, competitors are not permitted to seek any information from persons outside the Competition Area (e.g. members of the public, coaches etc.).

10) Volunteers

The Pump-Fest qualifier will be self-scoring however we will need judges for finals. SCWA will also take the opportunity to train Lead Judges at this event for next year's State lead titles. A volunteer link will be posted.

11) Schedule

The schedule will be posted to social media, emailed to competitors and will be on the City Summit notice board closer to the event.

The youth Top rope qualifiers will commence in the morning and wrap up around lunch time.
