What is it?

The Youth Future Cup is a new boulder series coming to Victoria. It is designed to **upskill, prepare and motivate current and future youth competitors**, for the format and challenges they will face at the national and international level, as well as provide opportunities for youth climbers to socialise and grow. At its baseline it provides **critical experience** for all upcoming youth climbers.

Format

The series will consist of 3 rounds, held over three consecutive weeks culminating in a finals.

Round 2 (The Crux): Friday April 5th

Round 3 + Finals (Boulder Lab Ferntree Gully): Friday April 12th

Qualifiers: 5-on-5-off, 4 boulders

Finals: 5-on-5-off, 4 boulders

Categories

There are 3 categories:

Development: (Youth C + D)

Junior: Youth B

Senior: Youth A + Junior

- Junior (Born 2005 & 2006)
- Youth A (Born 2007 & 2008)
- Youth B (Born 2009 & 2010)
- Youth C (Born 2011 & 2012)
- Youth D (Born 2013 & later)

Rules

To compete in this competition the climber agrees to follow all rules and regulations outlined in this information pack and follow the rules and procedures of the hosting gym.

This competition will follow [IFSC Boulder Rules](#) in a 5on5off format with cup style rounds.

Points system and finals

Each round will produce ranking points based on the IFSC World Cup points distribution (see *below: Appendix II*). At the conclusion of the qualifying rounds (after the qualifier of the 3rd round), the top 6 points scoring competitors in each category will proceed to the finals. For the avoidance of doubt, where there is a tie in the top 6 at the conclusion of the qualifying rounds, all competitors in the top 6 scores will proceed to the finals.
