Age Categories and Participant Requirements

Adults

- Open C *Beginners*: (Male V1-V4, Female V1-V3)
- Open B *Intermediate*: (Male V4-V7, Female V3-V6)
- Open A *Advanced*: (Male V6+, Female V5+)
- Master age 40+

IMPORTANT!

If you have already podium placed in any competition (both state or gym comp) you must move up to the next grade for your next grade for this competition. E.g. if you placed in an Open B competition you are no longer eligible to enter the Open B level and you must move up to Open A. Same applies to if you have previously podiumed in an Open C comp. You must now move up to Open B. If you feel that you require an exception to this, please contact the event organisers at info@sportclimbingwa.com.au

- Junior Born 2004 & 2005
- Youth A Born 2006 & 2007
- Youth B Born 2009 & 2008
- Youth C Born 2011 & 2010
- Youth D Born 2012 & later

Youth Competitor Policy change

In a specific calendar year, SCA state events **after** the national championships of that year will follow the same age categories definitions (by year of birth) than IFSC for the **following** calendar year.

Junior and Youth A competitors are permitted to compete in Open categories. Younger competitors are not permitted to compete in Open categories.

Junior and Youth A competitors who wish to compete in Open A as well as their age category will need to register and pay for both categories – there is a special bundle/joint price for this.

Interstate Competitors

Interstate competitors can compete but are not eligible for titles. They are eligible for ranking and prizes. International competitors are welcome but would compete under the same rules as interstate competitors.

Important Information

Climbers who are colour-blind need to notify the route setters via info@sportclimbingwa.com.au at least one week prior to the event.

By registering for this competition, the climber authorises SCWA to use images/photographs/movies that may be taken at the event. To revoke authorisation of the use of personal photographs taken from the event, the climber must submit in writing no later than the one week prior to event

Selection Process/Qualifying for National Competition

The 2022 WA Boulder State titles is the selection event for the 2022 Open Boulder Nationals and 2023 Youth Nationals.

Registration/Competition entry

Please note that you must be a current financial member of Sport Climbing Australia (SCA) in order to register for 2022 Boulder State Competition. If you need to renew your SCA registration then you will need to pay the \$30 SCA fee in addition to the SCWA Boulder States entry fee. We have kept our entry fees at 2021 prices to assist competitors.

Your SCA membership fee helps SCWA to fund and run the competition for you! SCWA is run by volunteers and we self-fund all our activities. Your membership of SCA also covers the insurance costs of running these events. Thank you for joining SCA!

It can be a little confusing to register! If you have trouble registering for the 2022 WA Boulder States, please check that you are a current financial member of SCA.

SCA Membership: All competitors must be current State members of Sport Climbing Australia. This costs \$30 for the calendar year.

Youth climbers in category Junior or Youth A are eligible to enter into the Open A Category if they wish. A special bundle price is available for those competitors.
